

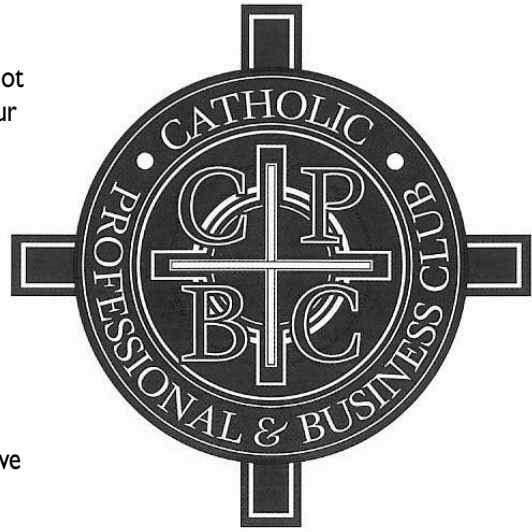


Mission Statement

NEW CPBC BOARD MEMBER PROFILE

This month we will highlight one of our newest CPBC board members, Jose Delgadillo. We welcome him to our board and we are grateful for his service and commitment to the Merced Catholic Business and Professional Club.

Jose came from Mexico in 1959 as an adopted son, Because of his lack of education and no knowledge of English, he was in the second grade at the age of 15. His new adopted parents (Maria and Angel Delgadillo) gave him the opportunity of a lifetime to get away from a poverty-stricken environment in Mexico. Jose graduated from high school and became a citizen in 1965. He served four years in the USAF during the Vietnam War. During the last few months in the Air Force, he became a third degree Knight of Columbus in the only military council at that time (1970).

After completing his military duty, Jose started his career with the Southern Pacific Railroad Co. in Sacramento and retired from Union Pacific Railroad in

1999. He graduated from Sacramento City College and Sacramento State University. From Sacramento, Jose was transferred to San Francisco where he met his wife Estrella (Bea) Soloria, who was instrumental in getting Jose back to Church. In his former parish in San Francisco (St. Emydius), Jose served as Chair of the Parish Council, member of the Liturgy Committee, and with his wife Bea was heavily involved in the Marriage Preparation Program. He remains involved with his former parish with the Filipino-American group as a Board member and past president. Bea and Jose relocated to Merced in 2006 and are involved in both the parish and civic community. They are members of a St. Patrick's small faith community and participate in the parish Dinner for 8. Jose is currently serving his second term on the Merced County grand jury. He transferred his Knights of Columbus membership to St. Patrick's Parish. We are delighted that this energetic new board member has joined us and look forward to serving with him.
