

Pauline Holy Year

Pope Benedict XVI has declared a special Pauline Year, beginning on the Eve of the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, June 28, 2008 and continuing through June 29, 2009. This year marks the 2000th Anniversary of St. Paul's birth. The Pope declared that a Plenary Indulgence (The remission of the temporal punishments for sins for one's self or for a Soul in Purgatory) may be received by anyone making a pilgrimage to the Papal Basilica of St. Paul's outside the walls of Rome during this year. Since the vast majority of the Faithful are not able to make this pilgrimage, the Holy Father has granted this plenary indulgence to anyone who attends a service in their parish on the inauguration and ending day of the Pauline Year, under the usual conditions of (Confession, Communion and Prayer of the Intentions of the Holy Father.)
